September 7, 1942 - May 5, 2016

Mr. Joe Cecil Wright, age 73, of Douglas passed away Thursday morning, May 5, 2016, at his residence following an extended illness. He was born September 7, 1942 to the late Cecil "J. C." Wright and the late Mattie Nipper Wright. Mr. Wright grew up in Douglas on South Daughtery Avenue playing with all his close cousin's. He was born sixteen years after his sister, growing up with almost two mothers. At an early age, Mr. Wright went to work at Coffee County Millworks where he developed a love of carpentry. Later, Mr. Wright followed in his dad's footsteps as a police officer. He was a member of the first graduating Criminal Justice class at South Georgia College. He then became the first motorcycle Cop for Douglas. Although he was a policeman for a short time, he always maintained an interest in the law. After working as a police officer, Mr. Wright went to work for Lewis Brother's Construction Company, which later became Tall T, gaining a greater knowledge of construction. In 1974, he married Maudine M. Wright and came to her family business, Douglas Electric, with knowledge of heating and air, as well as plumbing. Mr. Wright always kept up with the latest technology and helped to expand Douglas Electric into a successful business. Joe and Maudine also traveled to numerous foreign countries, developing a love for learning about foreign cultures. Recently Mr. Wright found a love for traveling around the surrounding states competing in BBQ competitions where he won numerous awards.
