



## Alex L. Mobley

August 16, 1927 - February 10, 2022

Mr. Alex L. Mobley, age 94 of Douglas, passed away Thursday morning, February 10, 2022, at his residence following an extended illness. Mr. Mobley was a Son, Brother, Cousin, Husband, Dad, Uncle, Grandfather, Great Grandfather and Great-Great Grandfather, Farmer, Sailor and Shipyard worker.

Born August 16, 1927 in Broxton, GA, he went to school in Broxton through the 3rd and part of the 4th grade He then dropped out of school to help support his family.
