



Carlos W. "Red" McKinnon

October 20, 1930 - June 30, 2020

Mr. Carlos Wilbur "Red" McKinnon, age 89 of Douglas, passed away Tuesday afternoon, June 30, 2020 at his residence following an extended illness. Mr. McKinnon was born October 20, 1930 to the late Jessie McKinnon and the late Fanny McKinnon. Mr. McKinnon was preceded in death by his first wife: Kathleen Tanner McKinnon, 2 Brothers: Aubrey McKinnon and Sarge McKinnon and 1 Sister: Ivaleen Mayne.

Mr. McKinnon, a native of Coffee County, was a locally known farmer and pastor. He was a Sergeant with the 11th Airborne Infantry, PM Company in Fort Campbell, KY. He served 3 years and 7 months during the Korean War. Mr. McKinnon was a member of Dry Creek Baptist Church in Nicholls and he also attended The Sanctuary in Douglas.
