November 29, 1943 - August 9, 2019

Mr. Clinton Batten, age 75 of Pearson, GA, passed away late Friday evening, August 9, 2019 at St. Vincent's Hospital Riverside in Jacksonville, FL. 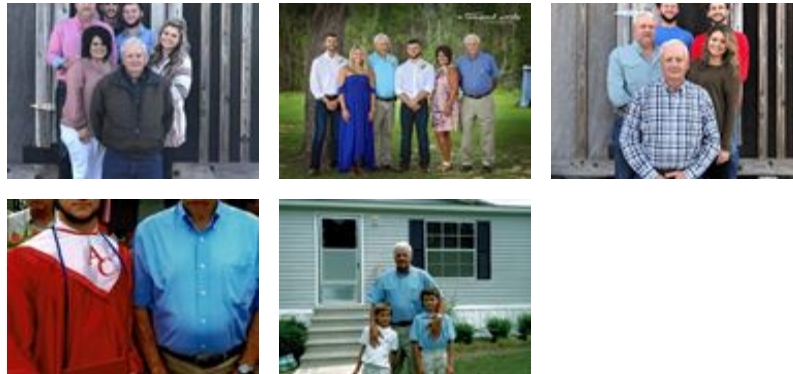
