



Clyde Eugene "Gene" Maynard

November 30, 1937 - June 12, 2020

Mr. Clyde Eugene "Gene" Maynard, age 82 of Broxton, passed away Friday morning, June 12, 2020 at Coffee Regional Medical Center following a short illness. Mr. Maynard was born November 30, 1937 to the late John H. Maynard and the late Alberta Layne Maynard. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a son: Erick Scott Maynard and a brother: Johnny Paul Maynard.

Mr. Maynard, a native of McAndrews, KY, was a veteran of the US Air Force, having served during the Vietnam Era. He was a former police officer with the City of Warner Robins, GA. prior to working at Robins Air Force Base as a Federal Police Officer for 30 plus years. Mr. Maynard was an avid motorcyclist. Each year on his birthday, he would make a trip on his motorcycle to Kentucky, West Virginia and North Carolina to visit his family and friends. This trip took place each year until his 80th birthday at which time his health had begun to decline and he could no longer make the trip.

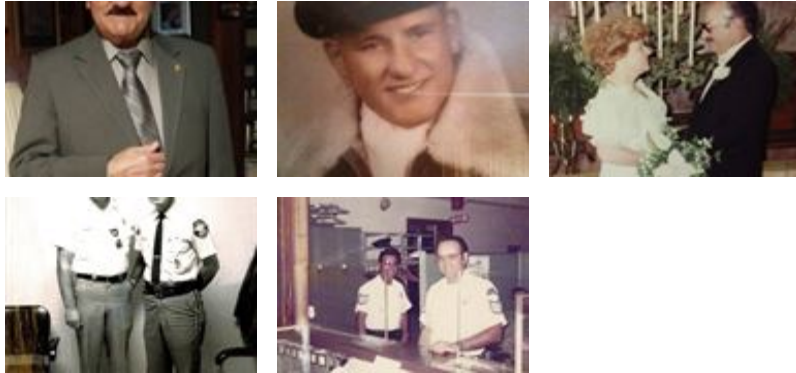
