



Glen Coleman Griffis

March 1, 1931 - August 2, 2016

Rev. Glen Coleman Griffis, age 85, of Douglas, GA passed away Tuesday afternoon, August 2, 2016, at Shady Acres Convalescent and Rehabilitation Center following an extended illness. Rev. Griffis was born March 1, 1931 to the late Elmon Griffis and the late Rilda Morgan Griffis. Rev. Griffis, a native of Coffee County, was a retired Holiness Baptist Minister. Rev. Coleman Griffis had ministered for many years throughout South Georgia, North Florida, North Carolina and Alabama. For over 20 years, Rev. Griffis also ministered through his local radio program "Camp Meeting Time". Rev. Griffis was also preceded in death by his wife, Jettie Mae Vaughn Griffis and 4 brothers, Melvin Griffis, Ellie Griffis, Elton Griffis and Neil Griffis. Rev.
