Rev. Hugh Jerome Hinson, age 60, of Ambrose passed away Wednesday afternoon, May 11, 2016, at the Medical Center of Central Georgia in Macon, following injuries received in an earlier auto accident. He was born August 9, 1955 and was reared by his grandparents, the late Dewey Hinson and the late Stella Carver Hinson. Rev. Hinson, a native of Coffee County, was a Licensed Minister in the Calvary Holiness Church. He was also a mechanic and farmer of the Ambrose Community.
