“ *I went to work at Sears in Lawton, Ok in the fall of 1965 at 16 years old in the parts dept. connected to the service dept. I work with Jack from then till he retired. I later went outside as a repairman and called back to the shop several times to ask Jack questions about what to do on a call. I was amazed that he always had the answer to help, and also amazed about how he could take things apart that were rusty with out breaking them. I bought a 1947 Plymouth painted aqua green the same color as the sears truck in that day from him in the spring of 1967 for \$35 unbelievable today. I remember he never wore a jacket to work in the winter unless it got down to 0-10 degrees then only his sears jacket without the liner. I had been thinking about Jack for the last year. I wished I had been able to talk to him one more time.*
