



## Raymond Wayne Day

May 15, 1945 - June 18, 2024

Mr. Raymond Wayne Day, age 79 of Ambrose, Georgia passed away early Tuesday morning, June 18, 2024 at Coffee Regional Medical Center following a brief illness. Mr. Day was born May 15, 1945 in Ocilla, Georgia to the late John Earl Day and the late Helen Vickers Day.
