



Victor "Bud" Adrian Cliett

November 28, 1912 - September 1, 2014

Mr. Victor Adrian (V. A.) "Bud" Cliett, age 101 of Broxton passed away Monday afternoon, September 1, 2014, at his residence, following a brief illness. Mr. Cliett was born November 28, 1912 to the late William Thomas Cliett and the late Algerine Jowers Cliett. Mr. Cliett, a native of Broxton, Coffee County, was a prominent farmer in the Pridgen Community. He was a former Revenue Agent for the State of Georgia. He was the oldest Revenue Agent in the State, with a badge for his position. He was later presented a Life Time Membership for his work with the Revenue Department of the State of Georgia.
